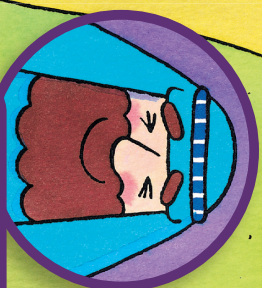
March! March!
Paul hates Jesus.



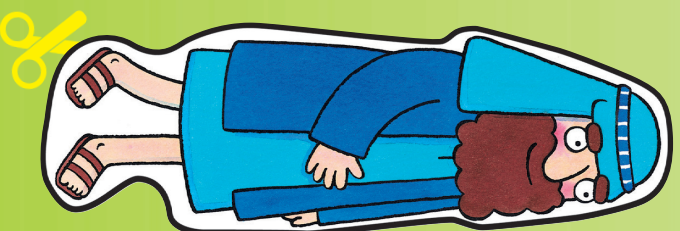
Bright light!

Today's aim is to discover that God wants and chooses people like us to be part of his plan.
Acts 9:1-19a

The good news for Paul (and for all of us) is that God understands and assesses people differently to the way we do.

Paul was the last person, humbly speaking, for the job. But he was

exactly the person God needed and chose. Whoever we are, God has a "place" for us – and we can each make our own response to him.

For a long time, Paul's mistaken but sincere response to God was "No". When his response became "Yes", it was wholehearted and total. Whoever we are, God is inviting us to be his friends. And whoever we are, we can say "Yes" to God.
